SIGNIFICANT FINDING

THE PAROS CLAN IS NOT RECORDED IN THE ANOGI RECORDS.

ASSUMPTION: THEY CAME FROM ELSEWHERE!

The 7 females of the Paros clan were known as Parenes living in an area of Stavros called Pareika. They made good wives as expressed in the local saying: “Stou Paro pas pare kai mi rotas!” (When you go to the Paroses take and do not ask)

Giorgios Paxinos Anemoyiannis died a hero's death during the Greek Revolution. In May, 1821 Giorgios, a young sailor from Paxos on a ship captained by Nikolaos Orlof, volunteered to steer a fire ship into the Turkish frigates anchored in the harbor of Nafpaktos. As he approached he was bombarded by cannon fire from the harbor fort and captured by the Turks who burnt him at the stake.
